How to Prepare & Separate Your Recyclables



Beverage Cans



- Please rinse completely.
- Aluminum & steel beverages can be separated at Litter Landing.
- Cans may be flattened.

Glass Jars & Bottles



- Remove caps & lids.
- Rinse clean.
- Separate, brown, green, & clear glass.
- Paper labels may be removed.
- **No** window glass, mirrors, ceramics, Pyrex glass, light bulbs, etc. accepted.

Cardboard: Corrugated/Pressed

- Corrugated is the cardboard with ridges.
- Shoeboxes, cereal boxes, etc. accepted.
- No wax-coated cartons or boxes.
- Pizza boxes accepted.



Hard Cover Books

Paperback Books

Paper Grocery Bags

- Paper grocery bags should be used to hold newspapers.
- Brown paper bags can be recycled with cardboard.

Newspaper



- Put in brown grocery bags or tie with twine.
- Do not leave loose newspapers.
- Inserts accepted.
- Clean, dry newspapers **ONLY**; no wet newspapers.

- Envelopes
- Junk Mail
- Greeting Cards - **NO** glitter/glue



Office Paper

Plastic Bottles

- Remove caps/lids & dispose.
- Rinse clean.
- Separate into categories:
 - * Milk jugs (natural color)
 - * 2-liter bottles & pop containers as well as clear containers
 - * Other containers #1, #2, #3, #5 & #7
- **Do not include** plastic bags, caps, lids, toys or other plastics #4 or #6
- No motor oil containers

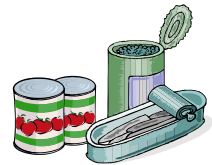


Aerosol Cans

- Remove caps
- Empty cans **ONLY**

Steel Food Cans

- Rinse Clean
- Separate from beverage cans
- Paper labels may be removed
- Cans may be flattened

- Aluminum foil, pie pans, TV dinner trays, etc.
